PLAN OF ACTION

PART - A

The IQAC of Smt. H. R. Patel Arts Mahila College, Shirpur has prepared a rough plan of action for quality enhancement in the beginning of the academic year (2009-2010) as under:-

- 9) To conduct special Remedial Coaching Classes for the students failed in the University exam.

PART-B

- 1) Activities reflecting the goals and objectives of the Institution:
- a) The students of the college have to participate in several programmes for the improvement of their personality. The programmes such as "Yuvati Sabha", "Annual Social Gathering", "Elocution and Debate Competition", "Savitribai Phule Study Centre Activities" etc. are compulsorily organized.
- b) The students are given opportunities to participate in creative activities and participation in several competitions through the different committees, such as- College Magazine, Wall Paper, and Literary Association etc.
- c) The students are made aware of the social commitment and community services. The activities of N.S.S. unit, such as -'AIDS Awareness', Polio Immunization, Literacy Awareness, Plantation, Gram Swachhata Abhiyan i.e. Cleanliness Campaigns, Blood Donation Camp, Hagandari Mukti (an open space toilet removal) Programme etc. bring out the necessary approach to the social service.
- d) The poor and needy students are helped by giving them concession in fees, supplying them books under Book Bank Scheme and financial help through Earn and Learn Scheme.

The volunteers organized and participated in several programmes such as- Farmers' Meet, Snake exhibition, World AIDS Day and Week, Anti-Superstition Programmes, National Pulse Polio-Immunization programme, Essay Competition on World Population Day, Elocution Competition on the Importance of Blood Donation etc.
- 4. The NSS students demonstrated through Street-Plays the social crime like the female feticide and the dowry system.
- 5. Two volunteers, Miss.Suvarna Rajput and Miss. Nutan Dorik participated in State and University level Disaster Management Workshop from 2nd July to 6th July 2009 and Personality Development Camp on 20th Sept.2009 respectively.

- 6. During the winter camp, the volunteers made the villagers aware of the campaign of the Dispute-Free Village and also guided them on behalf of the State Govt. and explained the role of the Govt. with its schemes and policies for the villagers' benefit.

20) Improvements in the library services:

The library is in the process of computerization. The library has installed the library software from LYBSYS, New Delhi which includes cataloguing, circulation, opac and acquisition etc with bar-coding. The internet facility is also made available in the library for the staff as well as the students.

22) Courses in which students assessment of teachers is introduced and the action taken on students feed back :

Forms of Appraisal of Staff by students are filled. Similarly, the meetings of the Students Council are also held for students feed – back about their assessment of teachers. The students are also asked to put their complaints about anything in the college in the complaint/suggestion box. The concerned teachers are given oral as well as written instructions by the Principal.

24) Computerization of administration and the process of admissions and examination results, issue of Certificates:

The office of the college has been computerized under the Xth Plan of UGC grant. The process of admissions and the issuing of certificates have been computerized.

25) Increase in the infrastructural facilities:

- a) The Language Lab of 10 seats has been established and the software from LinguaPhone-L21, London has been installed. The internet facility is also made available to the staff and the students.
- b) Similarly, the Computer Lab has been established having 15 computers and the internet facility is also made available to the staff and the students.
- c) The extension of the construction of the women's hostel is made from the grant Rs.60,00,000/-, sanctioned by the UGC under XI Plan.

26) Technology upgradation:

The Functional English Lab and Computer laboratory are equipped with ten and fifteen computers respectively. The computers in the Language lab are installed with the Lingua-Phone soft wares. The library has also installed computerized accession software, LYBSYS, (New Delhi).

27) Computer and internet access and training to teachers and students:

The office of the college, the Functional English Language Lab, the Computer Lab, and the college library have the internet connectivity of Broadband from BSNL. The staff and students are encouraged to have access for the same. The computer teachers train the students as well as the teachers how to access internet which is also a part of curriculum.

28) Financial aid to students:

The poor and physically handicapped students of the college are given financial help through 'Earn and Learn Scheme' and from college fund also.

29) Activities and support from the Alumni Association:

The Alumni Association has given financial assistance to the college and the poor and needy students are given financial support from that fund.

30) Activities and support from the Parent -Teacher Association:

The meetings of the Parent-Teacher Association are held from time to time. Suggestions and complaints raised in the meeting are taken into account for improvement of the college.

31) Health services:

The medical check – up for the students of the First Year B.A. and M.A. is made compulsory. A lady doctor visits the college twice a week for medical check – up. The students are advised to take medical treatment, if needed.

32) Performance in sports activities:

* Miss Rekha Bhoi, an M.A.(Marathi) student represented the college being the Member of the University Badminton Team. She got selected for the Badminton Tournament played at the Regional Level.
